Discussion on troughs for bridge area. Vice chair to take this forward.

Brackets: Secretary has sent out the necessary letters raising awareness of the need to check brackets for hanging baskets. One reply has been received.

Wrought Iron Signs: Mr. A. Stewart has volunteered to paint the wrought iron signs at the 4 entrance areas to town. The Committee would like to extend grateful thanks to Mr. Stewart for this generous offer.

Wordwright: Secretary to approach for permission to place 2 hanging baskets at corner of building.
