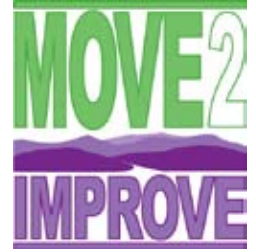


MOVE 2 IMPROVE MINUTES OF MEETING OF THURSDAY 24TH JANUARY, 2008.

Matters then followed Agenda.

Item 3) Eastern Approach. Isobel reported back that as per minutes of 20.07.06 Forestry Commission would like to see definite plans before they commit to supplying seating.

Tubs at W.B. Grieve site – Isobel and Elspeth will undertake to empty these containers and get them to Cathy's garage to let them dry. They will then be painted Holly Green and filled for summer.

Willie intimated that we have received a Standing Order from Wordwright for the 2008 Season. Although Wordwright have not expressed a wish for hanging baskets it is felt that this would be an excellent way to "Jazz" up the corner at the building.

Flower Power 2008. Rules drawn up for this discussed and agreed. It was also decided that the prizes would be 1st Prize and Runner up.

Isobel to send out letters to businesses who have joined the Hanging basket scheme this year Advising them of the weight of the baskets and the need for appropriate brackets being fitted.
