1. **Available Funds.** Update of funds from Treasurer and a review of outstanding bills.

2. **Car Park Update.** Half of the car park has been done. MW to contact Pete Butters to establish a programme for the other half.

3. **2009 Season.**

Watering Quotes: PM to prepare letters to send to the Golf Club and Donald Stewart. It was decided 100 baskets would need watering and fed once throughout the season. In addition car park tubs, Blairish tubs, BW monument planters, the Fountain, Bank Street bridge planters, the M21 train area and the troughs below the basket trees would all need to be included in the quote. WL to put notices at various locations in town requesting for additional people to quote for the watering.

New Hanging Basket Sites: New sites were identified as – next to the train, next to Fayre and Square, and possibly the entrance to the west end of town.

Stag Site: WL to photograph the site next to the traffic lights on the Crieff Road in preparation for planning application. MS to liaise with Iron Fairy re size of base so quote can be sought from Sean Campbell.

Putting Green Bed: MW reported that Paul Summers was drawing up a design for the hackle and that it was likely that part of the retaining wall would need to be rebuilt by the Breadalbane students. CR asked if more detailed plans could be sought from PS. MW to liaise with him.

Bank Street Bridge: WL to write to Rotary asking for confirmation of their plans to provide floral planters on both sides of the bridge.

Burns' Commemoration Bed. This is to be sited next to the Aberfeldy sign on Crieff Road. MS and MW to liaise together on this project for the next meeting. CR suggested that PS be contacted re reference dumping 3-4 tons of free compost at the above site ready for planting up the bed.
